

# National Certificate for Door Supervisors (Northern Ireland)

## Duration

30 hours

## Summary

- Under the Private Security Industry Act 2001, all door supervisors must hold a licence to practice
- This nationally recognised qualification is the industry standard and enables a door supervisor to apply for a licence to practice

## Details

The Level 2 NCDS(NI) is designed for those who wish to work in the industry; and is awarded to those who pass two examinations covering the basic knowledge and responsibilities of the occupation.

This nationally recognised qualification is the industry standard and enables a door supervisor to apply for a licence to practice.

The SIA issues licences to door supervisors who meet their criteria. In the interests of the industry as a whole and in support of its licence to practice, the SIA invited BIIAB and City & Guilds to work together to develop the BIIAB Level 2 National Certificate for Door Supervisors (Northern Ireland).

To qualify for an SIA licence you will need to satisfy three requirements:

- 1) Pass an identity check
- 2) Pass a criminal records check
- 3) Possess a recognised door supervisor qualification.

If you have completed a door supervisor training course and/or qualification you may be exempt from some or all of the SIA's training and qualification requirements. For a list of SIA's exemptions, visit <http://www.the-sia.org.uk>
