Summary

Anyone wishing to be employed as a security guard has to be in possession of a licence issued to them by the Security Industry Authority (SIA). This nationally recognised qualification is the industry standard and enables a security guard to apply for a license to practice.

Details

The Level 2 NCSG is designed for those who wish to work in the industry and provides candidates with the basic knowledge and responsibilities of the occupation.

The qualification consists of two units:

- Unit 1 – Roles and Responsibilities of Security Guards
- Unit 2 – Conflict Management for Security Guards
